YOUTH DIVISION

We had 7 members of the Helotes 4H team attend a week long CMP air rifle camp at MacArthur High school led by Armando Ayala from USA Shooting. Five of the seven finished in the top 7 places of the Camp's 3P match.

We had 2 Helotes 4H members (Paige and Carissa) attend the week long CMP Smallbore and air rifle camp at Camp Perry. There were top juniors from across the country to include new college shooters. We also had 2 members (Anne White and Isabella Rios) attend the National 3P air rifle competition at Camp Perry.

Helotes 4H's open house and registration was held on August 13th starting at 5pm at the Helotes Ag Center. We are expecting a increase in shooting members from all the recent success of our teams and in meeting new families at Camps.

HIGH POWER

The next quarterly CMP Games/Garand training match will be on Saturday, September 28th. It will be held at the CTSA Range, within the Dietz Shooting Complex, on TX46, west of New Braunfels, Texas. Match fee is \$20 for adults, \$10 for Military, and \$10 for juniors. Gate should be open by 0730. Fun begins at 0820 for setup and squadding. First rounds go down range at 0900.

We'll be shooting the CMP's 55 round 'B' course of fire from the 200-yard line. First stage will be slow fire prone, with 5 sighter shots and 20 record shots in 25 minutes. Second stage will be rapid fire, prone from standing, 10 shots in 80 seconds. Third stage will be rapid fire, sitting from standing, 10 shots in 70 seconds. Fourth stage will be slow fire, standing, 10 shots in 10 minutes. I will have some surplus Greek 30-06 ammo for sale, 55 rounds for \$15. The organization has a loaner Garand and a NM AR15 available for competitors to use, just let me know ahead of time.

Our next High Power training match will be on Saturday, October 26th. This will be the 80 shot NRA across-the-course training match. This will not be NRA 'Approved'. First and second stage will be at the 200 yard line, for both off hand and sitting rapid. Third stage will be at the 300 yard line for prone rapid. We'll finish the fourth stage at the 500 yard line for prone slow. Shooters will score and pull targets. Shooters choosing not to pull targets must provide a substitute puller.
